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FEDERAL CANDIDATES - - Survey Questions

1. With respect to any health care restructuring legislation, would you vote for language, along the lines of the Stupak-Pitts Amendment, that would cover all provisions of the legislation with strong prohibitions on federal subsidies for abortion and insurance plans that cover abortion, and strong guarantees against federal pro-abortion regulatory mandates, on a permanent basis (i.e. without requiring that Congress renew pro-life restrictions on an annual basis)?
2. Would you oppose any "health care reform" bill that does NOT contain language, along the lines of the Stupak-Pitts Amendment, that would cover all provisions on federal subsidies for abortion and for insurance plans that cover abortion, and guarantees against federal pro-abortion regulatory mandates, on a permanent basis?
3. Would you vote for the legal prohibition on all human cloning, including the creation of human embryos by human cloning?
4. Would you oppose all federal funding for stem cell research that requires the destruction of human embryos?
5. Would you vote to oppose any efforts to weaken or eliminate the current Hyde Amendment policy that prohibits federal Medicaid money from being used to pay for most abortions, or for being used for managed-care plans that include abortion?
6. Do you support the full reversal of Roe vs. Wade so that elected state legislative bodies may once again protect unborn children by limiting or prohibiting abortion?
7. Would you vote against any attempt to weaken or repeal current Federal law that prohibits most abortions at overseas U.S. military facilities?
8. Would you vote to reinstate the Mexico City Policy which restricts U.S. funding for most overseas abortions, and would you oppose any legislation that would prohibit a future president from reinstating the policy by executive order?
9. Would you vote against U.S. funding of the United Nations Population Fund, which participates heavily in China's population-control program that includes coerced abortion and promotes expanded access to abortion worldwide?
10. Would you vote for the Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act, and oppose weakening amendments, in order to make it a federal crime to transport a minor across state lines for an abortion, if this action circumvents a state law requiring involvement of a parent or judge in the girl's abortion decision?
11. Would you vote for legislation that would make abortion clinics, and organizations that operate abortion clinics, ineligible for Title X funding?
12. Would you vote for legislation to ensure that drugs federally controlled under the Controlled Substances Act may not be prescribed or dispensed for the purpose of assisting suicide?
13. Would you refuse to vote for a Speaker of the House, or Senate Majority Leader, who supports abortion on demand?
14. Would you refuse to campaign for, publicly endorse, or contribute to a presidential candidate who supports abortion on demand?

A note on candidates for judicial retention:

In Indiana, judicial candidates may be disciplined if they answer IRTL's questionnaires about abortion. Currently we do not have enough information on the candidates for judicial retention to accurately identify their positions. Indiana Right to Life is one of several plaintiffs seeking Supreme Court review of state regulations that place limits on the ability of judicial candidates to campaign for judicial office.

4. Do you oppose Planned Parenthood's use of peer educators who are students trained and paid by Planned Parenthood to promote Planned Parenthood activities and events on campus?
